EID UL FITR

Eid is a very special, auspicious and joyous religious Holiday for all Muslims all over the world. Eid is a day to glorify Allah T'ala, a day to thank Allah Subhanahu Wa T'ala for His guidance and for His innumerable bounties and blessings. It is also a day of caring and sharing. It is very important that we celebrate this beautiful and joyous Holiday in real Islamic spirit. The Messenger, *Salla Allahu Alayhi Wasallam*, said to the people of Madinah, who used to celebrate two celebrations before Islam, “Allah has given you better than those (two) feasts, Eid Al-Fitr and Eid Al-Adh’ha.”

Furthermore, it is imperative to follow the Sunnah of the Prophet in celebrating our Eid which entails the following:

- It is obligatory to pray Eid prayer. It was reported that, “the Prophet and his companions never ceased from performing it, and they always gathered the people for it.”
- Dress in the best clothes you have.
- Eat dates before leaving for Eid prayers
- Say Takbeer, Alahu Akbar loudly. The Prophet used to say Takbeer until he finished the prayer.
- Do not perform any voluntary prayer either before or after Eid prayer.
- Take one path when going to Eid prayer and a different path when returning from it and recite Takbeer all the way
- It is allowed for children to sing songs and have benign Eid Festivities on Eid..
- It is obligatory to pay Sadaqat ul Fitr before Eid prayer on behalf of all the dependents including the new born. Muslims are prohibited from celebrating their feast in sinful or evil ways.

Sadaqatul Fitr & Zakah

Alhamdulillah, Your Center has organized a program to help the widows, the orphans and the needy Muslim families on emergency basis. Please send your Zakah, Sadaqat, Fitr and other charity to help the needy in our community.

Sadaqatul fitr is \$7:00 per person for every member of the family including the new born baby and it must be paid before Salatul Eid. *JazakAllah Khairan Katheera!*
